





The darker the red, the more people in the ZIP code who are not vaccinated for COVID-19. Select a ZIP code to highlight the bar chart.







Overall, there have been 43,398 vaccine breakthrough cases identified in Oregon.

Breakthrough cases have been reported in all 36 counties.

As some go unreported, the true number of vaccine breakthrough cases is unknown.

Through November 18, OHA said that 2,639,902 residents have reached full vaccination. That means those 41,257 breakthrough cases represents only 1.6% percent of the entire fully vaccinated population. Source

During the week of November 14–November 20, there were 5,875* cases of COVID-19. 4,203 (71.5%) were unvaccinated and 1,672 (28.5%) were vaccine breakthrough cases.

How to At Work Mandates

OSHA Work Mandate

The 5th Circuit issued a stay pending adequate judicial review of OSHA's emergency temporary standard (ETS) (a/k/a/Mandate) that all employees at private companies with more than 100 workers must get COVID-19 vaccinations, or be tested weekly. This reaffirms the court's temporary stay issued on November 6.

The court ordered that "OSHA take no steps to implement or enforce the Mandate until further court order."

A federal judge blocks Biden's vaccine mandate for U.S. Health Workers

"There is no question that mandating a vaccine to 10.3 million health care workers is something that should be done by Congress, not a government agency," Judge Doughty of U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana wrote. He added: "It is not clear that even an act of Congress mandating a vaccine would be constitutional."
