



Track county progress toward 80% of people 18+ years old vaccinated. Labeled with current rate and relative percent change between 10/02/2021 to 10/09/2021.



Labeled with % people vaccinated with at least one dose





Labeled with % people vaccinated with at least one dose



Breakthrough Cases Oregon

During the week of October 03–October 09, there were 9,141 cases of COVID-19. 6,651 (72.8%) were unvaccinated and 2,490 (27.2%) were vaccine breakthrough cases.

The median age of breakthrough cases was 47 years.

65 (2.6%) breakthrough cases were residents of care facilities, senior living communities or other congregate living settings.

616 (24.7%) cases were 65 or older.

There were 122 (4.9%) cases aged 12-17.

Small businesses are going into the crucial holiday period and a good portion of these businesses are bars and restaurants.

Buy local is a strong theme to generate business given supply chain issues that may negatively affect product availability for their online competitors, but...

...consumer confidence, especially around one's safety, must be INCREASED for the vaccinated in order for them to re-enter the marketplace during holidays and re-ignite foot traffic in our neighborhoods.

It is not safe to do so without a proof of vaccination mandate for those experiences where it is necessary to be unmasked among people who may be unvaccinated and social distancing is not possible in bars and restaurants, especially when the unvaccinated are young adults.

That's been my experience.

These did not work for my 93 year old friend who I joined for a drink in a bar we all frequent on September 5th and who died on September 20th of COVID-19. We both sat next to a woman who was not vaccinated and did not wear a mask. We thought we were among friends, all vaccinated. I did not get sick. I was lucky, but I do not feel particularly lucky. My friend was the first person I know among close friends who died from COVID-19. There is no proof here, but a cautionary tale. The bar is in Old Town. Use the list on page 15 to find bars and restaurants who have instituted proof of vaccination mandates.

The vaccinated living in Multnomah County need more than hope, prayer and luck.

THE COMPLEX BUSINESS OF VACCINE MANDATES

Tougher mandates may be necessary—but we shouldn't ignore the harm that they can cause.



Throughout the covid-19 <u>pandemic</u>, American leaders have considered the pros and cons of vaccine mandates. Until recently, they've held back. Mandates, their role in the Revolution notwithstanding, have been condemned as "un-American"; the covidvaccines are also new, and only recently received full approval from the Food and Drug Administration. Carrots—lotteries, cash payments, gift certificates—have seemed preferable to sticks. And yet, today, a third of eligible Americans are not fully vaccinated against covid-19. More and more, mandates look like **our surest path to normalcy**.
